This week in Reading we learned all about first and secondhand accounts. A first hand account is written from the authors perspective. In this type of writing you will find pronouns like I, me, and we. The author will also share what they were thinking and/or how they were feelings. Examples of first hand accounts are diary or journal entries, letters, and autobiography. Second hand accounts are pieces that are written based on research or what the author has learned. In this form of writing you will see pronouns like he, she, and they. In second hand account the author will share facts, but will not share much, if any, of their own opinion.

Examples of second hand accounts are biographies, informational writing, and encyclopedias. This weekend spend some time reading some of your favorite informational texts and determine if they were written in first or second person.

Today in class we had a conversation about appropriate outerwear as the temperature starts to drop. For health reasons I ask that all students wear a jacket at all times during recess if they are wearing short sleeves. I understand that some students are very active during recess, which causes them to warm up and want to shed their winter coats.
