A run-on sentence is when two or more sentences are combined without the proper use of punctuation and/or conjunctions.

This week in Math we started our new unit on

comparing fractions. Students learned how they can draw models to determine if one fraction is greater than, less than, or equal to another. They can continue to practice and build fluency with this skill over the weekend by playing this fun game!
