We survived out first week back after track-out! I was super impressed this week by the way students were able to jump back into our routine after having a month off! So kudo's to them!

In Social Studies this week we began our new unit on economics. This is by far one of my favorite units! We started this week by learning how the quality of a product helps determine it's price. The more it costs to make, the more you must charge. We put this lesson into action by having a taste test. Students were able to taste lemonade made 3 different ways. Lemonade A was made with two caps of mix and 2 cups of sugar. Lemonade B was made with one cap of mix. Lemonade $C$ was made with I I/2 caps of mix and I cup of sugar.

The majority of the class thought Lemonade A was
the best, followed by C, and then B. As a class we determined that due to taste preference and the amount of materials it used, A should be the most expensive and $B$ should be the least expensive. This weekend I encourage you to try this investigation at home. Purchase 3 versions of a treat you like in varying price points. Is there a difference in quality from the one that costs the most to the one that costs the least?
