Alright friends, we're entering the final stretch of the school year!

We have one more reading standard to finish next week, as well as one last math standard. After that we will be in full on review mode. As I stated in my Friday email, we will begin an extra round of math review in the afternoon from 2:05 to $2: 45 \mathrm{pm}$. It will be imperative that your child is here on time every morning, so they won't miss reading review, and that they stay all day, so they won't miss the additional math review. Of course, I understand if there are emergencies or appointments that you have already scheduled, but it would be amazing if we could finish the year out with perfect attendance!

This week in math we started our unit on line plots. Line plots use symbols
like an x or a dot to show data on what looks like a number line. In class the students practiced their measuring skills by drawing a line segment that measured $0-1$ inch to the nearest I/8 of an inch. After that we collected data on how many lines there were of each of the varying lengths on a chart. Then we the chart to create a line plot. You can continue this over the weekend by creating your own line plots. For example, how many of each color car did you pass when you were driving to run an errand. Or, walk around the house and measure objects of varying lengths and display that data in a line plot.
