1. Expanded Form- Writing a number to show the value of each digit $(400+70+6)$
2. Standard Form- a number written in the way most commonly accepted form (476)
3. Word Form-A way to write numbers in standard English (four hundred seventy-six)
4. Estimate-an approximate calculation or judgment of the value, number, quantity, or extent of something
5. Rounding- a method used to shorten numbers that involves either increasing or decreasing a number to the next digit.
6. Greater Than- (>) is symbol used to compare two numbers, with the greater number given first
7. Less Than -( < ) is a symbol used to compare two numbers, with the lesser number given first
8. Equation-a statement that the values of two mathematical expressions are equal (indicated by the sign =)
9. Reasonable-when an answer is a good approximation or estimate to the question
10. Prime- a whole number greater than 1 , whose only two whole-number factors are 1 and itself
11. Composite- A whole number that can be divided evenly by numbers other than 1 or itself Factor Pair- a set of two numbers, which when multiplied result in a definite number
