4. **Board** - a long, thin, flat piece of wood or other hard material, used for floors or other building purposes
5. **Break** - separate or cause to separate into pieces as a result of a blow, shock, or strain
6. **Brake** - a device for slowing or stopping a moving vehicle, typically by applying pressure to the wheels
7. **Capital** - upper case letters of the alphabet, an important city or town that usually has the government and administrative center in it, a valuable resource
8. **Capitol** - a building in which a state legislative body meets
9. **Principle** - a basic idea or belief that influence how people behave
10. **Principal** - most important - a leader in a school
11. **Scent** - a distinctive smell
12. **Cent** - a monetary unit of the US, Canada, and various other countries, equal to one hundredth
