Math Vocabulary

1. Decimal- represents a fraction whose denominator is a power of ten and whose numerator is expressed by figures placed to the right of a point
2. Fraction-a numeric value that is not a whole number (e.g., $1/2$, 0.5)
3. Units-a term used to express a quantity chosen as a standard expression
4. Equivalent-equal in value, amount, function, meaning, etc
5. Measure-a certain the size, amount, or degree of (something) that's determined by using an instrument
6. Metric-a system that is based on the meter as a unit of length; gram as a unit of mass, and liter as a unit of capacity
7. Customary -a system of measurement in the United States and includes measurements such as the mile, feet, pounds, and gallons
8. Convert/Conversion-a change in the form of a measurement, different units, without a change in the size or amount
9. Length- the measurement of how long something is
10. Mass- a measure of how much matter/weight is in an object
11. Distance- an amount of space between two things or people
12. Line Plot- a graph that shows frequency of data along a number line
