1. Utter- make (a sound) with one's voice
2. Propose- put forward (an idea or plan) for consideration or discussion by others.
3. Chortle- laugh in a breathy, gleeful way; chuckle.
4. Coax- persuade (someone) gradually or by flattery (complimenting) to do something
5. Hypothesize- put (something) forward as an idea or thought for consideration; wondering something
6. Imitate- copy (a person's speech or mannerisms), especially to be funny.
7. Mimic- imitate (someone or their actions or words), typically in order to entertain but sometimes to be unkind
8. Nag- annoy or irritate (a person) with continuously asking them or bothering them to do something
9. Sneer- a disrespectful or mocking smile, remark, or tone.
10. Taunt- something said to anger, hurt, or annoy someone
11. Surmise- to assume something is true without solid evidence
12. Divulge- to share private or sensitive information
